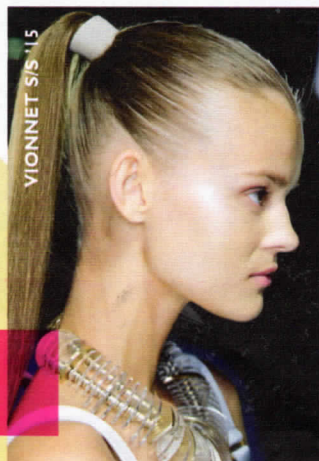


## 6 FORGET BLOW-DRY BARS – IT'S ALL ABOUT THE peel bar...
